

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy applies to www.midwestoutdoorskillstraining.com, and Taaza Taree LLC dba Midwest Outdoor Skills Training (collectively, "**MOST**") and governs data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, all references to MOST include www.midwestoutdoorskillstraining.com and Taaza Taree LLC dba Midwest Outdoor Skills Training. The MOST website is an information, registration, and e-commerce site. By using the MOST website, you consent to the data practices described in this policy.

Collection of Your Personal Information

To better provide you with the products and services offered, MOST may collect various types of personal information from you, including, but not limited to:

- Contact information (e.g., name, email address, phone number)
- Demographic information (e.g., age, gender, location)
- Account credentials (e.g., username, password)
- Payment details (e.g., credit card information)
- Information provided through forms or surveys
- Website usage information (e.g., IP address, browser type, referring pages)
- Communication preferences

We do not collect any personal information about you unless you voluntarily provide it to us. However, you may be required to provide certain personal information to us when you elect to use certain products or services. We also may gather additional personal or non-personal information in the future.

Use of Your Personal Information

MOST collects and uses your personal information to operate and deliver the services you have requested. MOST may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from MOST and its affiliates.

Sharing Information with Third Parties

MOST does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. MOST may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to MOST, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

MOST may disclose your personal information, without notice, if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on MOST; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of MOST; and/or (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of MOST, or the public.

Tracking User Behavior

MOST may keep track of the websites and pages our users visit within MOST, to determine what MOST services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within MOST to customers whose behavior indicates they are interested in a particular subject area.

Automatically Collected Information

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by MOST. This information can include your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times, and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain the quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding the use of the MOST website.

Security of Your Personal Information

MOST secures your personal information from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure. MOST uses the Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) Protocol for this purpose. When personal information (such as a credit card number) is transmitted to other websites, it is protected through the use of the SSL protocol. We strive to take appropriate security measures to protect against unauthorized access to or alteration of your personal information. Unfortunately, no data transmission over the Internet or any wireless network can be guaranteed to be 100% secure. As a result, while we strive to protect your personal information, you acknowledge that: (a) there are security and privacy limitations inherent to the Internet which are beyond our control; and (b) the security, integrity, and privacy of all information and data exchanged between you and us cannot be guaranteed.

Right to Deletion

Subject to certain exceptions set out below, on receipt of a verifiable request from you, we will:

- Delete your personal information from our records
- Direct any service providers to delete your personal information from their records

We may be unable to comply with requests to delete your personal information if it is necessary to:

- Complete the transaction for which the personal information was collected, fulfill the terms of a written warranty or product recall conducted under federal law, and provide a good or service requested by you, or reasonably anticipated within the context of our ongoing business relationship with you, or otherwise perform a contract between you and us
- Detect security incidents, protect against malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal activity; or prosecute those responsible for that activity
- Debug to identify and repair errors that impair existing intended functionality
- Exercise free speech, ensure the right of another consumer to exercise his or her right of free speech, or exercise another right provided for by law
- Engage in public or peer-reviewed scientific, historical, or statistical research in the public interest that adheres to all applicable ethics and privacy laws, when our deletion of the information is likely to render impossible or seriously impair the achievement of such research, provided we have obtained your informed consent
- Enable solely internal uses that are reasonably aligned with your expectations based on your relationship with us
- Comply with an existing legal obligation
- Otherwise use your personal information, internally, in a lawful manner that is compatible with the context in which you provided the information

Children Under Thirteen

MOST does not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children under the age of thirteen. If you are under the age of thirteen, you must ask your parent or guardian for permission to use this website.

Email Communications

From time to time, MOST may contact you via email to provide announcements, promotional offers, alerts, confirmations, surveys, and/or other general communication. If you would like to stop receiving marketing or promotional communications via email from MOST, you may opt out of such communications by replying STOP.
